Parking Information

Pacesetter Park has a limited number of spaces for on-site parking. Only those with a **Tournament Parking Permit** will be allowed to park at Pacesetter Park **from 6:30am-6:00pm on Saturday and Sunday**.

Please follow the instructions below for parking during the tournament. Sylvania Recreation and PSI ask you to please park **ONLY** in the designated areas. Please be aware that Sylvania Township Police will ticket and tow, at the owner's expense, any vehicles parked in area residential neighborhoods and on public streets.

Parking Passes

A limited number of tournament parking passes will be provided to each visiting team, through the team's manager, for distribution to families who may need direct access to the park. Vehicles with Handicap Parking passes will be granted access to the park without a tournament parking pass.

Player Drop-off Area

If you are not one of the few to receive a parking pass or if the Pacesetter parking lot becomes full, you may drop-off players in the designated drop-off area (please refer to the facility map). You **must** enter the facility from **Mitchaw Rd** and follow the signage to the designated player drop-off area. Upon dropping off the players, you must then exit the facility back to Mitchaw Rd and park your vehicle in the designated shuttle parking lot. Please note, the **Player Drop-off** area is a different area than the **Shuttle Bus Drop-off/Pick-up** area. You will not be permitted to use the Shuttle Bus Drop-off/Pick up area to Pick-up players.

Shuttle Parking

Shuttle services will run from the shuttle parking lot located at the intersection of Centennial Rd and Brint Rd. in Sylvania between the hours of 6:30 am-8:00 pm on Saturday and Sunday. There will be 4 busses making this 1 mi. trip during this time for your convenience. Please note the **Shuttle Bus Pick-up/Drop-off** area located on the facility map.

Lot Full

Should the lot at Pacesetter become full, a **Lot Full** sign will be posted at both entrances to the facility from Sylvania-Metamora Rd. and Mitchaw Rd and even those with a permit will need to use the shuttle services until parking spaces become available. **This will affect Pacesetter Park – Parking Permit Holders. Player drop off will still be allowed at this time.**
